

2018 TRAVEL GRANTS FOR NURSES



Early career nurses are eligible for travel awards. Masters and Doctoral students and early career investigators within 7 years of receiving their doctoral degree are eligible to apply for a travel grant to the HFSA Annual Scientific Sessions. Ten (10) travel grants of \$1,250 each will be awarded. Although it is not required to submit an abstract to be considered for the travel award, preference are given to those that have accepted abstracts. Awardees will be notified by July 2nd.

To be eligible:

1. Membership in HFSA is required.
2. Submission of an abstract to the 2018 Scientific Meeting is mandatory.
3. A personal statement about your professional or academic scholarship related to heart failure must be submitted with the application. This should be no longer than one single spaced page (preferably one-half page) for the travel award. See page 2 for the personal statement form.
